Fabrique des Arts de la Rue

The street is in Amiens from 17 to 20 June 2010

For its 33rd edition, the Fête dans la Ville festival welcomes the public from 17 to 20 June 2010, for a week-end of parties, parades and shows. About thirty companies will present their creations to a always larger number of spectators – **40.000 people last year** - inviting them to let the artists transport them in their imaginary world, to let themselves be surprised, to laugh and to dream.

Every year in Amiens and since 1978, the greatest names of street arts turn the city and its districts upside down, accompany its evolution and create deep bonds with its inhabitants and visitors. Street artists now have an official place allocated to them along the year thanks to **Le Hangar**, a space for creation and work dedicated to street arts, and **the Pôle Régional des Arts du Cirque** (Regional Centre for Circus and Street Arts) - that has been officially recognized as a **National Centre this year** - developing many projects, along territories and festivals from northern Europe* : Brest, Loos-en-Gohelle, Sotteville-lès-Rouen, Southampton, Brighton, Great Yarmouth, Winchester, Newhaven.

Among the companies programmed in 2010, **Ilotopie** will present the public its last creation, « Les Oxymores d'eau » (« Water Oxymorons ») : an outstanding nocturnal show on water, in the heart of Saint-Pierre Park; **The Pipototal company** will install in the city its gigantic acrobat machine. **Luc Amoros** will present an act on the role of the images in our societies while **Charli Encor**, after a fascinating period of work in Amiens with disabled persons, will choreograph a ballet of wheeling chairs in urban environment...

At only 1 hour of Paris and Lille, this festive event is also the occasion of discovering a city that supports actively every form of culture while possessing an exceptional natural and historic heritage : the hortillonnages and the market on water ; the Cathedral ; the Circus Jules Verne, etc.

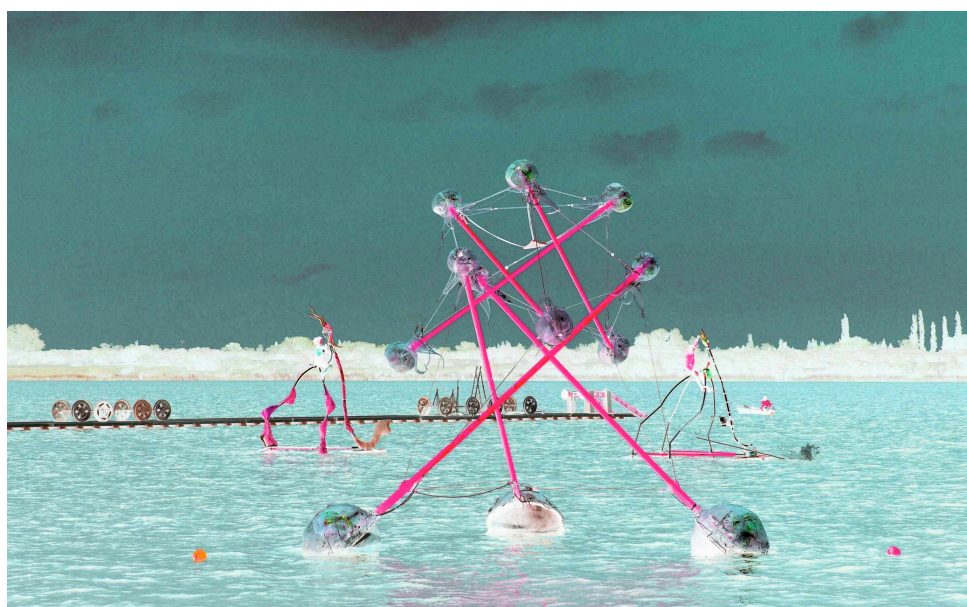
This show, played for the first time in Amiens before to be programmed in London, is a tribute to water, the show of a natural man full of images and contradictions. In order to meet the Oxymorons, the audience will come at nightfall on the banks of the Saint-Pierre lake. In a forgotten universe, between disuse and abundance, the public will see tender and sensitive beings emerge mischievously and adapt to the rising of water levels and to the wet love stories...

In order to work on water and imagination, its landscapes and new uses in the city -two strong topics in Amiens- for this show working with « positive energy », the Ilotopie company has created floating structures stocking the daylight and releasing it at night to better enchant us.
