

The House where Jules Verne lived from 1882 to 1900 today offers a space where the imagination and daily life of the second most translated writer in the world combine.

Immerse yourself in the atmosphere of a 19th century bourgeois mansion in which the author wrote more than half his work.

Get to know his publisher Hetzel, his cardboard boxes, his office where the greatest novelists of the time took a seat.

In this tower house, follow in the footsteps of Jules Verne and discover his main sources of inspiration and the legacy of his work.


Writing workshops
